- ▶ appliances 10yrs. old or newer, clean & working
- ▶ architectural items
- ▶ bricks & blocks  
no pickups – drop off only
- ▶ bicycles
- ▶ cabinets
- ▶ cabinet doors & hardware
- ▶ ceiling fans complete & clean
- ▶ ceramic tiles 4 boxes or more of the same tiles
- ▶ counter tops no cutouts or corners
- ▶ desks 4ft long or shorter
- ▶ doors & hardware  
no hollow core (flush) doors
- ▶ electrical supplies & light fixtures
- ▶ fencing vinyl or wood clean, vinyl or wood only no broken pieces
- ▶ flooring carpet, new padding, vinyl, rugs, hard wood (full boxes only)
- ▶ framed art & mirrors
- ▶ furniture non-smoking home, no pet hair, no stains, no rips, no mold or water damage
- ▶ garden tools & outdoor furniture
- ▶ hardware
- ▶ LED light bulbs
- ▶ lumber sheets & dimensional, 4' minimum, no nails or screws
- ▶ lawn mowers, snow blowers, tillers must work
- ▶ shutters new only
- ▶ sinks
- ▶ toilets clean, low-flow (1.6 gal) only
- ▶ tools
- ▶ windows under 8 years old, complete

## unacceptable donations

- ▶ box springs or mattresses
- ▶ bunk beds, loft beds
- ▶ ceiling tiles & grid
- ▶ clothing
- ▶ counter tops with cutouts or corners
- ▶ cooktops
- ▶ cultured marble sinks
- ▶ curtain rods
- ▶ dishes, kitchen items
- ▶ dishwashers
- ▶ used ductwork
- ▶ entertainment centers
- ▶ exercise equipment
- ▶ florescent fixtures or bulbs
- ▶ furnaces
- ▶ futons
- ▶ garbage disposals
- ▶ unframed glass or mirrors
- ▶ hollow core (flush) doors
- ▶ humidifiers or dehumidifiers
